The saloon has a multi fuel stove in a tiled fireplace, sofa bed with storage under and under gunwale shelves. The galley features a breakfast and a good range of appliances. The bathroom is a walk through, followed by the bedroom , which has a cross bed, but could also be used conventionally, under bed storage, wardrobes and over head cupboards. The engine room houses all services. lovely, high quality boat in pristine condition.
